- The contractor must follow CPWD Safety Code as provided in general conditions of contract for CPWD Works.**
- Any damage done by the contractor or his workmen to any existing work during the course of execution of the work shall be made good by him at his own cost.**
- Contractor shall clear the site thoroughly of all rubbish etc. left out of his materials immediately on completion of the work and properly clean the site around the building to the satisfaction of the Engg.-in-Charge. Otherwise the site will be cleared by the department at his risk & cost to remove and clean the site.**
- The contractor to whom the work is awarded will have to sign the agreement on non judicial stamp papers of Rs.50/- and the cost of such stamp paper will be borne by the contractor.**
- Cement bags shall be stacked by the contractor at space provided by ITPO of stipulated quantities at his own cost in his own.**
- Cement shall be kept under double lock system in space provided by ITPO fixed with the door.
