Dear Mi Bardlow

As you might be aware, the National Archives of India (NAI) is mandated with the task of keeping, conserving and making accessible to users the non-current records of the Government of India. In this regard, I wish to draw your kind attention to clause (c) of the sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Public Records Act, 1993, to be read with Rule 5 of the Public Records Rules, 1997 that envisages "appraisal of Public Records which are more than twenty five years old in consultation with the National Archives of India with a view to retain public records of permanent value and transfer of these records to National Archives of India".

- Further, sub-rule (2) of Rule 9 of the said Rules also states that "no public record which is more than twenty-five years old shall be destroyed by any records creating agency unless it is appraised." In this connection, previously issued circular to 93 Ministries/Departments and 209 PSUs, in response only 15 Ministries/Department/PSU such as President's Secretariat, Prime Minister's office, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Coal Ministry of Railways, Ministry of Law & Justice, Ministry of Science, National Archival Of India, Central Board of Film Certification, NHPC, Deputy Salt Commissioner Tamilnadu, etc have carried out the appraisal work and approximately 61,769 records appraised and 12,923 records were transferred to National Archives of India for permanent retention.
- In view of above, and in the interest of timely management of records, I would request you to 3. kindly instruct the designated officials to review and assess the records more than twenty-five years old in your Ministry/Department or the subordinate offices, autonomous bodies, PSUs, etc., functioning under your administrative control and to inform NAI about the requirement for the appraisal of records. Kindly recall that under the Special Campaign 4.0 for Swachhata in Government offices in 31 October 2024, an exercise of sorting of the files has probably already been carried out in your organization; this should provide material for appraisal of identified records. Based on your information, NAI will initiate necessary procedure to appraise these records and subsequently, selected appraised documents would be accepted by NAI for preservation and management.
- I look forward to your support in strengthening the record management practices in Government of India and the efforts towards the long-term preservation of records of enduring value.

I shall be grateful for an early response in this regard.
